MIXED OPEN AND WOMEN'S 27

Following the enormous effort of our Selectors and Coaches, and after a meeting of the Board of Clubs tonight, Switzerland are thrilled to announce registration of a **Mixed Open (MXO)** and **Women's 27 (W27)** team to ETC2016, which has been confirmed by EFT.
